



# Palm Oil Trade Impacts: Germany

Germany exported EUR 12.385 billion worth of goods to Malaysia, Indonesia, and Thailand in 2017. The EU's protectionist Palm Oil ban would lead to trade retaliation and harm Germany's long-term growth.<sup>1</sup>
