



# Palm Oil Trade Impacts: Netherlands

The **Netherlands** exported EUR 3.566 billion worth of goods to Malaysia, Indonesia, and Thailand in 2017. The EU's protectionist Palm Oil ban would lead to trade retaliation and harm Netherlands' long-term growth.<sup>1</sup>
